Stormwater Program Update

Staff provided an update on recent activities as follows:

Condition Assessment

Staff continues to work internally and with Vision NC and Sungate Design to assess the stormwater infrastructure.

Residential Assessment

The 50 residential assessments were completed by the contractor, Mike Dupree. A survey has been sent out, and next month’s meeting will include a presentation of the project results.

Outreach and Education

Last month Carrboro Stormwater staff participated in the Orange County Creek Week. Upcoming events include outreach for Earth Day, Carrboro Day, and other spring events.

New Board Members Orientation

Staff gave a brief orientation to the Commission to familiarize new members with the Town’s requirements for all advisory board members. This included referencing resources such as the Town code and Rules of Procedures Document. It was also noted that there may be an upcoming townwide orientation for all new members to Town Boards and Commissions.

Joint Review Discussion

There was a discussion of the joint review to follow this meeting. This included orienting new members to the purpose of joint reviews and the role of the board. The Jade Creek site was discussed, including SWAC comments for the concept plan in 2022.
